

# Belle Fourche Rail Park Awarded Federal Railroad Administration Grant



As the rail business continues to grow in Belle Fourche, so does the need for additional siding track to accommodate customers. Belle Fourche Development Corporation (BFDC) recognizes the importance of education and reinvestment as new rail customers come on board.

In 2018, the BFDC board of directors started the written proposal to apply for a Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) grant from the Special Transportation Circumstances (STC) Grant Program. The grant application process was very thorough and included presentations to the South Dakota State Railroad board over the past year.

This week, the grant award recipients were announced, and Belle Fourche was one of four locations named as an awardee for up to \$1,917,710.

The economic impact of this investment is significant and gets the Belle Fourche Industrial & Rail Park another step closer to the original rail siding plan. Rail use can offer a significant transportation cost savings. As more rail customers consider Belle Fourche as their hub for transporting goods and materials, it creates more jobs which drives good strong community development. This is a big win for Belle Fourche!



The Belle Fourche Industrial & Rail Park rail siding will soon see additional track to better accommodate customers. The FRA SCT grant funds will go towards rail infrastructure to accommodate up to 90 cars at the siding. With the recent increase in new customers and inquiries the additional track will allow for new business and more jobs to support the business.

The Belle Fourche industrial & Rail Park is located just off of Hwy 85 along Hwy 212 with 74 acres available for development. For more information, contact the economic development office at 605-892-5065.

#### Federal Grants Awarded for Rail Projects

PIERRE, S.D. – The South Dakota Department of Transportation has learned that four grant requests have been approved to receive Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) grant awards.

The awards come from the Special Transportation Circumstances (STC) Grant Program which is program under the Consolidated Rail Infrastructure and Safety Improvements (CRIS) Program and the Restoration and Enhancement Grant Program.

The State Railroad Board approved grants requests applications on the following projects for use of the federal STC funds available to South Dakota.

Grant funds were awarded as follows:

- Sisseton Milbank Railroad Lake Farley Bridge Replacement (up to \$1,549,848)
- Dakota and Iowa Railroad Main Line Rail Replacement and Crossing Improvement Project (up to \$3,992,758)
- Belle Fourche Industrial and Rail Park (up to \$1,917,710)
- Ellis and Eastern Sioux Falls Area Bridges (up to \$3,919,840)

"The STC funds are dedicated to three states, South Dakota, Wyoming and Alaska, that do not have passenger rail (Amtrak)," says Joel Jundt, Transportation Deputy Secretary. "These special federal funds are dedicated to rail projects within these states and these funds give us important financial resources to improve the state's railroad infrastructure which is vital to shippers, rail companies and citizens."

While these grants are non-competitive, the SDDOT needs to ensure the projects meet eligibility requirements with FRA. The SDDOT will be responsible to administer the grants and oversee the work. Each grant is funding with a maximum federal amount not exceed 80 percent of the total cost of a project. The required 20 percent non-Federal match amount is being paid by the respective private entity requesting grant funds.
