\$30 million funds create affordable housing options across Black Hills in anticipation of B-21 Bombers

RAPID CITY, S.D. - Senator Mike Rounds visited Elevate Rapid City Monday morning to announce \$30 million in funding to bring muchneeded affordable housing to communities



across the Black Hills.

The <u>South Dakota Ellsworth Development Authority</u> and <u>Black Hills Area Community</u> <u>Foundation</u> partnered with Senator Mike Rounds to establish locally led trust funds in the following communities: Lead-Deadwood, Spearfish, Sturgis, Ellsworth, **Belle Fourche**, Hill City, Hot Springs, Custer and Rapid City.

Rounds said the goal of this funding is to provide options for housing across the Black Hills and for people at Ellsworth Air Force Base as they gear up for the arrival of the B-21 Bombers.

"A lot of these individuals will live not on base but close by the base or somewhere in the Black Hills itself. So as they come in they'll look for where they want to live and where they want their kids to go to school. But you got enlisted personnel that may live on base or they may live off base," Rounds explained.

The emphasis on supporting the entirety of the Black Hills was a goal of all the organizations engaged in this project. Black Hills Area Community Foundation CEO Chris Huber says the housing wouldn't be possible without the funding.

"We've started the Rapid City Strategic Housing Trust Fund already and we've got six loans approved and three more in process. That'll create 630 affordable housing units in Rapid City alone. This funding today allows us to expand that model across the Black Hills," Huber said.

Rounds also noted the Douglas School District will need some improvements and said he met with local leaders to find ways to fund school expansion projects before the arrival of the bombers.


