

The city, county, chamber, and economic development all have a role in shedding light on the best practices for ultimate community development and how to accomplish it by setting goals and working together.


Having a greater understanding of how the life blood of a community flows really helps to create community for the people who live in it, the folks we serve.



PAYCHECK PROTECTION PROGRAM HAS REOPENED

The Paycheck Protection Program resumed accepting applications July 6, 2020, at 9:00 AM EDT in response to President signing the program's extension legislation. The new deadline to apply for a Paycheck Protection Program loan is August 8, 2020.

PAYCHECK PROTECTION PROGRAM LOAN INFORMATION

The Paycheck Protection Program is a loan designed to provide a direct incentive for small businesses to keep their workers on the payroll.

SBA will forgive loans if all employee retention criteria are met, and the funds are used for eligible expenses. <u>Click here</u> to read more about PPP loan forgiveness.

How To Apply

You can apply through any existing SBA 7(a) lender or through any federally insured depository institution, federally insured credit union, and Farm Credit System institution that is participating. Other regulated lenders will be available to make these loans once they are approved and enrolled in the program. You should consult with your local lender as to whether it is participating in the program. View a list of lenders participating in the Paycheck Protection Program by state.

If you wish to begin preparing your application, you can download a copy of the <u>PPP</u> borrower application form (revised June 24, 2020) to see the information that will be requested from you when you apply with a lender.
