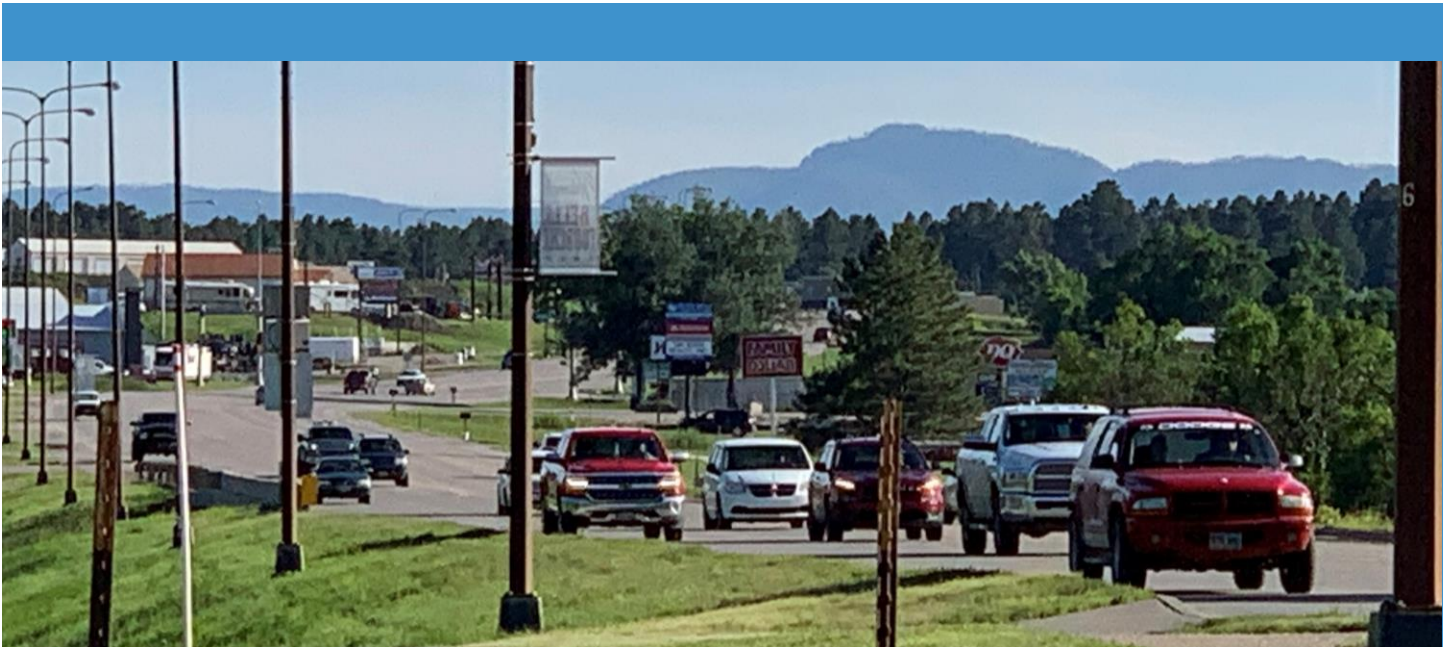

Thank you to the council people today and those on council who helped start this venture together in 2015. It is serving the community with public parking and a community building used for multiple organization's meetings and community development work.

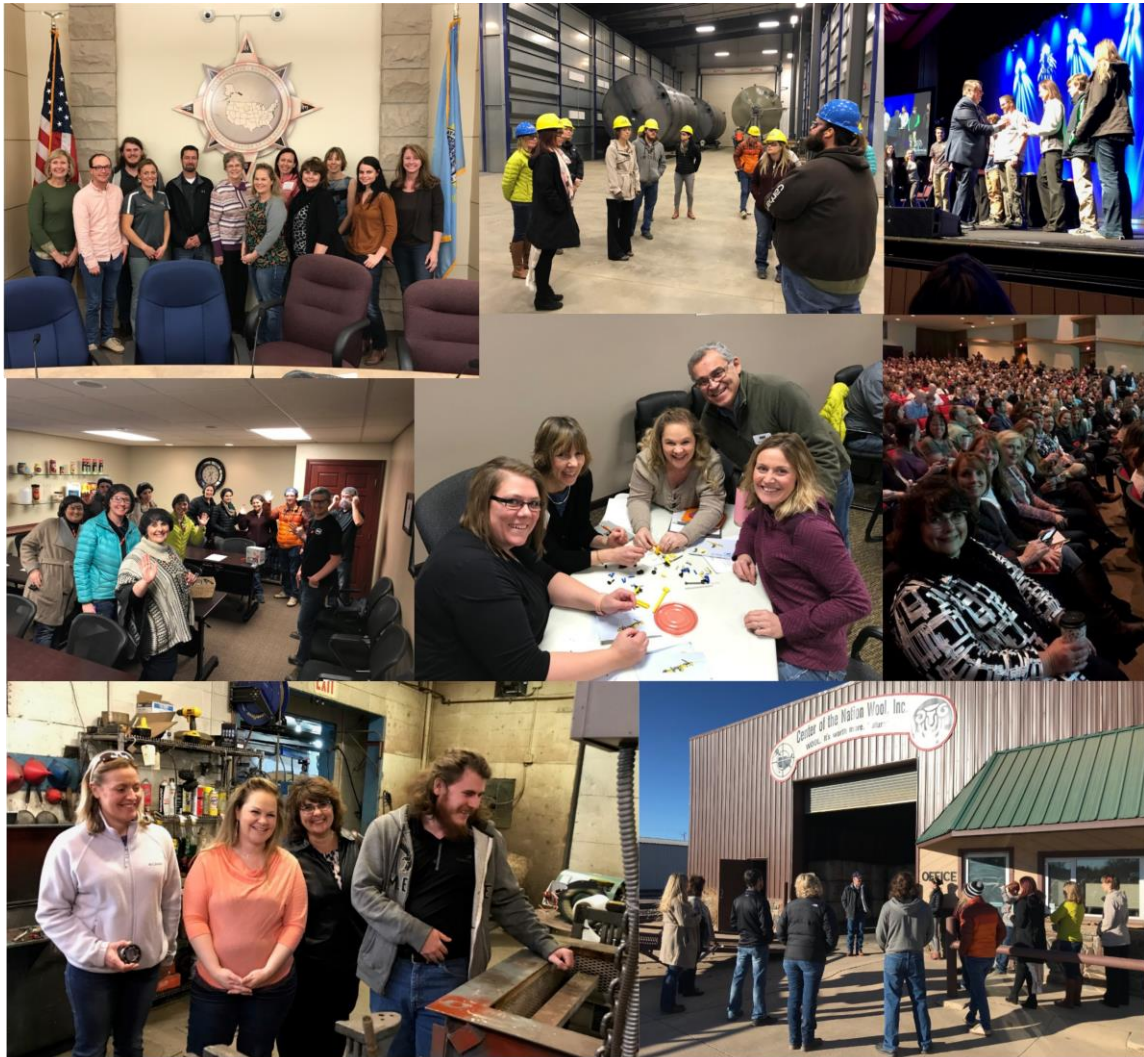
